What your group is being tasked with is to learn all about one of the communities above to research. Your research should answer the following questions:

PAST

1. What does the word 'community' mean to you? **1-2 sentences**
2. When did the group first come to Canada? **1-2 sentences**
3. Why did the first group come to Canada? (Pull factors) **About 5 sentences**
4. Why did the community leave their country of origin? (Push factors) **About 5 sentences**
5. Where did the community live in Canada? (Include a map) **1-2 sentences**

PRESENT (2019)

1. How has the population of the community changed since they first arrived in Canada? (Increased, decreased, remained stable) **1-2 sentences**
2. Where does the community now live in Canada? **1-2 sentences**
3. What is a challenge the community faces today in Canada? **About 5 sentences**
4. How has the community contributed to the creation of the Canadian identity and community? **About 5 sentences**
5. Create one inquiry question you are curious to know more about in regards to your community. **1-2 sentences**

You may choose how to present this information to the class- Google Slides, iMovie, diary entry, poster board, etc. Be creative!
